

How to remove a **LEFT** ear mould.



1. Using either your LEFT thumb or a finger, feel for the back edge of the ear mould and 'lever' the mould out slightly.



2. Get hold of the back edge of the ear mould between your finger and thumb.



3. Gently pull the ear mould backwards to remove from the ear (depending on the shape of your ear canal you may also need to twist the mould slightly to remove).

Each night when you remove your hearing aid always wipe the ear mould with a damp cloth or wet wipe to keep it clean. Ear mould tubing should be replaced every 4-6 months by our Audiology Department.
