<p>1. Go to http://bestpractice.bmj.com/info Select Login</p>	
<p>2. Select 'Access through your institution'. If you do not have an Open Athens account, you can register for one at http://www.evidence.nhs.uk</p>	
<p>3. Select "NHS England" as organisation and enter your Open Athens user name and password.</p>
