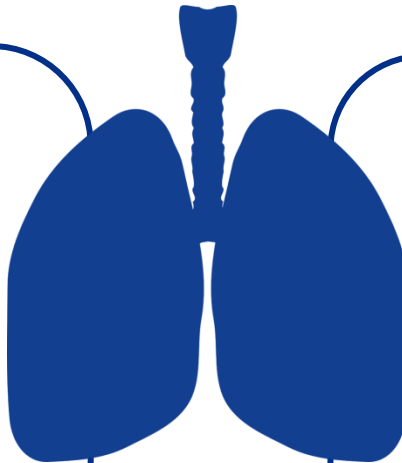


Role of the Macmillan Lung Cancer Nurses
