WUTH's Cheshire and Merseyside Surgical Centre at Clatterbridge has been successfully accredited as an elective surgical hub delivering high standards in clinical and operational practice.

The scheme, run by NHS England's Getting It Right First Time (GIRFT) programme in collaboration with the Royal College of Surgeons of England, assesses hubs against a framework of standards to help hubs deliver faster access to some of the most common surgical procedures.
