Pump Up Positivity - Supporting Community Health and Wellbeing

A group of local parents, including Kiri Smith from our 1st Floor Therapies Team, are campaigning for the development of a new cycle pump track in the Bebington area.

While this is a community initiative, it has clear links to the wider aims of the NHS. Safe, accessible outdoor spaces encourage regular physical activity, support children and young people to build confidence and coordination, and help families stay active together. Evidence shows that increased physical activity in childhood supports long-term health and can reduce future strain on health services.

The proposed pump track would be inclusive, free to use, and designed to offer a safe environment for riding, playing and developing bike skills, helping to promote healthier lifestyles across the local area.

Kiri and the team are seeking support from colleagues to strengthen their petition as they explore funding options and community backing.
