June Richards (née Boyle) sadly passed away after a long and courageous struggle against breast cancer. She will be hugely missed, not just by Ian, Megan and Ellie, but also by all the family, her many friends and her work colleagues. June was the most caring person, working as a nurse in the NHS for over 42 years. She volunteered to be one of the first in the country to test the COVID vaccine and bravely donned PPE to test for COVID infection. She had a wicked sense of humour (she blamed it on working on the wards in her formative years), two university degrees and loved a glass of wine (usually New Zealand Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc chilled beyond the recommended temperatures).
