Changes to resuscitation training requirements

In the coming weeks, all staff will see updates to their ESR compliance relating to resuscitation training.

Resuscitation Level 1 will be added to staff who do not currently undertake any practical resuscitation training. This will be delivered as an e learning package and will appear on your ESR learning tab. Staff are asked to complete this at the earliest opportunity.

For colleagues who complete Resuscitation Level 2 training, this will be updated and split into three areas: adult, paediatric and newborn resuscitation.

There is no change to how staff enrol onto Level 2 training. Colleagues should continue to use the ESR compliance and competency page, searching for 408 Resus Level 2 to book onto the next available course.

The Resuscitation Training Team will deliver the appropriate training based on individual requirements, and the Learning and Vocational Development Team will update ESR to reflect competencies achieved.

Not all staff will need to complete all three Level 2 areas. Please refer to your ESR compliance record for the specific training required.
