Digital training opportunities now available

At Wirral University Teaching Hospital and Wirral Community Health and Care, we are continuing to embrace digital transformation by investing in our people and their skills.

Two fully funded programmes are now available, delivered by Imperial College London and Corndel through the apprenticeship levy.

The Data Fundamentals Level 3 Programme is ideal for those looking to improve data literacy and work more efficiently. It covers areas such as automating routine tasks, managing data and making the most of tools like Excel. The programme runs for 12 months, followed by a two-month end point assessment.

The Data Analyst Level 4 Programme is designed for those wanting to develop more advanced data skills. It includes analysing complex data, building dashboards and using tools such as Excel, SQL and Power BI to support decision making. This programme runs for 16 months, followed by a three-month end point assessment.

An information session for the Level 3 programme will take place on 24th April.

Applications for the Level 4 programme close on 5th May.

These programmes offer a great opportunity to build confidence and capability in data, supporting both personal development and service improvement.
