Delivered via MS Teams, the sessions provide practical guidance and tools to support colleagues across a variety of topics.

Sessions available this June include:



- **Essay Writing and Referencing - 4th June (3pm-3.30pm) and 29th June (10.30am-11am)**
Learn the basics of academic writing, including how to write clearly and concisely, properly reference evidence and avoid plagiarism.
- **Reflective Writing - 8th June (10.30am-11am)**
Explore how to write reflectively and build on previous knowledge and experience.
- **Finding the Evidence - 22nd June (3pm-3.30pm)**
Learn how to search for articles and access information across a wide range of resources.
- **Health Literacy - 22nd June (1.30pm-2.15pm)**
A practical session focused on communicating in ways that help patients better understand health information.
- **Medical Terminology - 24th June (3pm-3.30pm)**
A brief introduction to understanding medical terminology commonly used within hospital and NHS settings.

These sessions are designed to support colleagues in building confidence, developing practical skills and accessing resources to support both everyday practice and wider professional development.
