Staff invited to the launch of WUTH's Bereavement Care Strategy

Colleagues from across the Trust are invited to attend the launch of WUTH's new Bereavement Care Strategy on Friday 2nd October 2026 at Arrowe Park Hospital.

The launch will mark an important milestone in our work to ensure patients approaching the end of their life are cared for with dignity, compassion and respect, while families and those closest to them receive the information and support they need.



The new strategy will provide a clear Trust wide vision and framework for end of life and bereavement care at WUTH.

It will bring together a range of work taking place across the organisation, including our Making Memories keepsake initiative, advance care planning, spiritual and chaplaincy care, staff education and training, and our commitment to listening and responding to the experiences of patients and families.

The launch follows the [recent introduction of our new Support for Relatives and Carers leaflet](#), which was co designed with patients, relatives and carers who shared their experiences of end of life care at WUTH.

Their feedback helped shape a practical resource providing families with clearer information and guidance on the support available while their loved one is receiving end of life care.

The Bereavement Care Strategy builds on this work and will help us continue improving the experience and support we provide to patients and families at one of the most difficult times in their lives.

All staff across the Trust are welcome to attend the launch and learn more about the strategy and the work taking place across WUTH.
