Living Well Bus offering cervical screening at Arrowe Park

The Living Well Bus is coming to Arrowe Park Hospital on Wednesday 26th August, giving eligible colleagues an opportunity to access cervical screening conveniently while at work.

The bus will be located between the main hospital and the Women and Children's building and will be offering cervical screening to staff until 4pm.

The service is available to anyone aged 25 to 64 with a cervix, and there is no need to make an appointment. Simply visit the Living Well Bus on the day.

What to expect

Cervical screening is a quick and discreet procedure. The professional team on the Living Well Bus is experienced in supporting people who may feel nervous or anxious about screening, so please let them know if you have any concerns or require additional support.

Regular cervical screening is an important way of preventing cervical cancer. It checks the health of the cervix and can identify certain types of human papillomavirus that can cause changes to cervical cells.

If you are eligible and have been putting off your cervical screening, the visit provides an opportunity to get up to date without needing to arrange a separate appointment.
